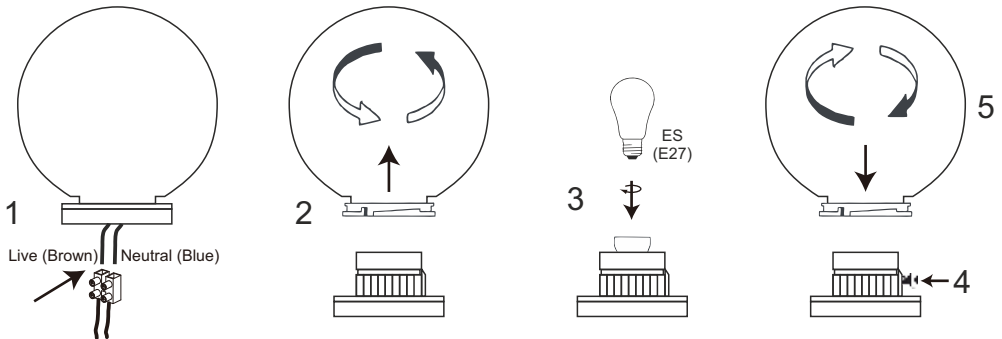

- Any broken or damaged parts should be replaced as soon as possible.

- Accessories available: 3 Types of wall fixing brackets, poles, top pole bracket and waterproof gasket.

Installation Instructions:

- Ensure mains supply is switched OFF.
- Connect mains supply cables ensuring Live and Neutral polarities are observed: Brown = Live (L) and Blue = Neutral (N) (1).
- Remove the globe cover by turning it anti-clockwise (2).
- Fit lamp into the lamp holder (3).
- Secure the fitting in place by tightening the base screw (4).
- Re-fit the globe cover by turning it clockwise (5).
- Switch the mains supply ON and test the fitting.



Information for the Product User:
